Complete your online check-in and book your arrival time.

Link your credit card to your expense account during online check-in to avoid queues onboard.

Track your expense account while onboard.

Expenses are in USD and holds may be placed on your linked credit card. These serve to secure funds for onboard processed transactions and are not actual charges.



Chat with family, friends and other guests onboard.

The app is available for free from the Apple App Store and Google Play Store. Once onboard, you can use the app for free by connecting to your ship's Guest Wi-Fi network. You do not need to purchase an internet package to use the app. In-app purchases available.

Before you Arrive



Download the Royal Caribbean App and complete your online check-in. Please ensure that your passport is valid for **at least 6 months after your sailing's return date**. We recommend to check-in on the same day as the rest of your travel party to request the same arrival time.



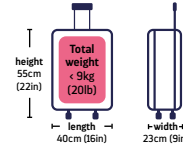
Start your mandatory guest safety briefing using your Royal Caribbean App on the day of boarding.



Answer the health questions on the app the day before you sail. You'll get an email and app reminder.



Guests must print the luggage tag found in their Royal Guest Document (eDocs – electronic document) and attach it to their checked luggage before boarding. Loose baggage such as paper bags and camera bags should be hand-carried.



Ensure that your hand-carry items adhere to luggage size guidelines with a maximum dimension of 55cm x 40cm x 23cm. Kindly check in oversized bags before embarking and disembarking the ship.

Boarding Day

Parking space may be limited, so we highly recommend being dropped off at Level 2 of the terminal during your arrival time.



Arrive only during your pre-selected check-in/wellness screening time with your entire travel party. All members must check in together. Arriving outside of your appointed time will delay your boarding.



Be sure to keep important items like travel documents within easy reach. You'll need them when you arrive at the port up to boarding the ship.



Once onboard, report to your assembly station reflected on your Royal Caribbean App to complete your Guest Safety Briefing.





All guests are required to complete the Singapore Arrival Card prior to disembarkation. Download the [MyICA Mobile](#) app or [click here](#) to complete.

Disembarkation








Assigned departure times begin at approximately 7:00 am (refer to the disembarkation letter delivered to your stateroom on the last night for more information).


